### **Job Overview**

We are seeking a dedicated and passionate Teacher to join our educational team in the PK3 classroom starting in August 2026. The ideal candidate will play a crucial role in helping to deliver high-quality education and care to children. This position is perfect for individuals who have a strong interest in early childhood education and are eager to contribute to the development of young minds in a nurturing environment.

This position reports directly to the Managing Director and Pre-Primary Division Head. Teachers are expected to be at school Monday-Friday from 7:30am-3:30pm while school is in session. There are opportunities for additional pay through After School Programs (ASP) and Summer Camp.

Assistant Teachers should be able to incorporate multiple teaching styles and varied approaches with their students and should possess strong interpersonal and written communication skills. A passion for education, a love of teaching pre-primary children, intellectual curiosity, the ability and inclination to work as part of a team, and a commitment to ongoing professional development are expectations of the position.

### **Job Requirements:**

- Work with his/her Lead Teacher (LT) in implementing all aspects of the curriculum.
- Teach whole group lessons as directed by the LT, including instruction in core learning components such as English / Language Arts, Social Studies, and Mathematics.
- Be present in the classroom and fully engaged with the students during instructional periods.
- Assist the LT in evaluating students, provide input for report cards
- Assists the LT in providing learning accommodations.
- Steps in for the LT if/when the Lead is absent.
- Works with individual students and small groups as directed by the LT.

- Assists in preparing lesson materials, centers, transitioning students to and from the classroom, and supervises students at recess and lunch.
- Shares handling of behavioral/disciplinary issues as they arise.
- Communicates with parents as needed and/or directed; attends and contributes to parent/teacher conferences.
- Attends training sessions as directed
- Attends all division and School meetings.
- Is evaluated annually by the Managing Director and/or the Division Head.

**Required Skills/Abilities:**

- Exceptional verbal and written skills.
- Tact and poise when interacting with parents of young children.
- Good judgement.
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail; ability to prioritize, take initiative, and address several challenges simultaneously.
- Pleasant personality, collaborative style, professional demeanor, appearance, and attitude.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality

- CPR Certification (prior to first day of school)
- Experience working with Pre-Primary children.
