



WAYS OF GIVING

GIFTS OF CASH*

The School will gratefully accept checks made payable to Gulf Stream School or charges to a Visa, MasterCard, or American Express card. Donors are entitled to an income tax deduction for the year the gift is made.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES*

The School gratefully accepts readily marketable, publicly traded securities and in some cases, unregistered securities. Donors who give appreciated securities benefit in two ways. First, they pay no capital gains tax on the amount of the increase in value and secondly, their income tax deduction is equal to the average price of the security on the day the gift is made.

Many companies offer **matching gift programs for gifts made by employees (or the employees' spouses) to non-profit organizations. These programs are a great way to increase your contribution to the School. Inquire of your employer whether your company offers a matching program, and if it does, ask them to give you the proper forms. You will receive credit for the original gift and the matching gift. Both you and the company will be acknowledged in the Annual Report.*

GIFTS OF REAL ESTATE

The School may accept gifts of real estate (homes, lots, commercial, or industrial property). The tax deduction equals the fair market value of the property at the time of the donation. Additionally, the donor avoids the payment of capital gains tax.

BEQUESTS AND TRUSTS

Planned Giving is an excellent way to ensure a bright future for the School. Join The Heritage Society by including Gulf Stream in your estate plans. Those who make a provision for Gulf Stream in the form of an irrevocable bequest or trust are eligible. Please notify the Development Office so we can acknowledge your generosity and add your name to our records.

GIFTS OF LIFE INSURANCE

Donors may transfer ownership of an existing life insurance policy. The tax deduction equals approximately the current cash surrender value. You could also purchase a new policy, making the School the owner and beneficiary. In both cases, you are entitled to an income tax deduction for the premiums you pay each year. A gift of life insurance qualifies the donor for The Heritage Society.

Prospective donors are encouraged to discuss their charitable giving plans with their legal, financial, or tax advisers. Gifts are deductible as provided by law. Please contact the Development Office at (561) 276-5225 if you have questions.







The Florence Jackson Clough Endowment Fund for Scholarship was established by the bequest of Mrs. Clough, a generous friend and neighbor of the School. Each year, income from this fund is contributed toward Gulf Stream's commitment to providing scholarship assistance to able students who otherwise would not be able to attend Gulf Stream.

The Anne G. Gibb Scholarship Fund provides income to be used each year to enrich the scholarship offerings at Gulf Stream School. In June 2004, an anonymous donor created a \$100,000 challenge to award scholarship funds to a family or families that would not be able to afford the cost of tuition and/or fees. The recipient must meet the minimum requirements for admission and remain in good academic and disciplinary standing. Any unused portion of the income will be reinvested into the fund balance.

Income from this fund may be used to enhance both libraries' collections or to curtail the costs associated with operating the facilities. Funds will be distributed annually equally at the discretion of the Head of School. The principal is to remain intact and any unused portion of the income will be reinvested.

The Gulf Stream School Technology Fund was initiated in 2011-2012 thanks to a gift from the Chester Foundation. The fund was established to further advance the role of technology across the curriculum. Funds may be used to research and purchase new hardware and software, to establish and support courses centered around technology and technology-aided learning, or to provide professional technology development for teachers. When the fund grows to a sufficient size, income may be used to support technology faculty positions. The donors started this fund with the intent that others would add to the principal in order to ensure the Gulf Stream School students and faculty have access to the most current technology. Annual income will be used at the discretion of the Head of School. The principal is to remain intact and any unused portion of the income will be reinvested.

The Building Maintenance Fund for Field House and Computer Center, established in 1996, provides funds for the upkeep of the School's physical plant, specifically the maintenance of the Sylvester Field House and Sylvester Computer Center.

The Ann Rentschler Cassady '41 Memorial Endowment Fund was established in 1997 by Mr. William Cassady, Miss Rita Cassady '73, Miss Rowena B. Cassady Frazel '77, Mrs. Raina B. This Endowment Initiative seeks to create a revenue stream to make an annual Gulf Stream School Speaker series a reality. These speakers will encourage learning and exploration in a variety of subjects, professions, and passions, as well as provide opportunities for lifelong learning. The David Winans Speakers Series will provide insight into life's possibilities and generate fresh perspectives for our student body and School community.

The "Z" Fund was initiated in January, 2018 with a generous commitment from the Zarcadoolas and Galloway families and subsequent gifts from other members of the Gulf Stream School community. The families made this gift to honor Joseph J. Zaluski, Gulf Stream's eighth Head of School who retired in 2019. Mr. Zaluski led Gulf Stream School for fourteen years

and steadfastly promoted the value of different perspectives. Mr. Zaluski was also an unwavering advocate for the personal and professional growth of every member of his faculty and staff. This fund is designed for, but not limited to, use at the Head of School's discretion for professional development opportunities and to honor and reward longtime, dedicated members of the faculty and staff.
